Resolution No. 298

53nd session on 1st September 2016

to the Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the conditions of entry and residence of third-country nationals for the purposes of highly skilled employment /COM(2016) 378 final, Council reference 10012/16/

Conclusions of the Resolution:

The Committee on EU affairs:

1. **does not support** the Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and the Council on the conditions of entry and residence of third-country nationals for the purposes of highly skilled employment, COM (2016) 378 final;
2. **insists on** maintaining of the decisive role of the Member State of the European Union in the field of legal migration and employment, including preserving the right of individual Member States to determine volumes of legal migration;
3. **clearly rejects** the prohibition of parallel national systems, limiting the possibility of testing the labor market and extending the scope of the directive to holders of international protection because it is inconsistent with the principle of subsidiarity, and **adopts the reasoned opinion** pursuant to the article 6 of the Protocol (No. 2) on the application of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality;
4. **supports** the government framework position to this document;
5. **nominates** the Chairman of the Committee on EU affairs to submit the reasoned opinion via the Chairman of the Chamber of Deputies to the Government, to the Chairman of the Senate, to the Chairman of the European Parliament, to the Chairman of the Council of the EU and to the Chairman of the European Commission, pursuant to the Rules of Procedures of the Chamber of Deputies.
