4. **supports** the position of the Government on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council adapting a number of legal acts in the area of Justice providing for the use of the regulatory procedure with scrutiny to Article 290 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, COM (2016) 798 final, Council reference 5705/17;
5. **appreciates** the progress made by the Commission towards greater transparency in the delegated acts procedure compared to the provisions contained in the three legislative proposals (Omnibus I, II and III) submitted by the Commission in 2013;

6. **welcomes** the fact, that the Common Understanding between the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission on Delegated Acts accompanying the Inter-Institutional Agreement on Better Law-Making, addresses also the matter of regular consultation of Member States' experts;
7. **expresses** doubt as to whether the procedure of consultation of Member States' experts taking place during the preparation and drafting of delegated acts as stipulated in the Common Understanding between the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission on Delegated Acts accompanying the Inter-Institutional Agreement on Better Law-Making is definite and binding enough;
8. **empowers** the Chairman of the Committee on EU affairs to submit this resolution to the Chairman of the Commission **in the context of political dialogue.**
